Planting day this coming Saturday 12 June (120 plants).

Any time you can spare between 9 and midday is appreciated. You can choose what job you can take on – light or heavy.

We have tools – but bring sturdy footwear and cover for arms and legs.

We're well and truly in the swing of the planting season. 7000 wetland plants in the ground to date in the Taupo swamp wetlands' restoration – and our first 2019 plantings are now over 2 metres high with all that gorgeous runoff coming down from the Catchment. Our weeding volunteers continue to do a great job to get those away. Thank You!
