It has been a challenge with Covid, but we are proud that the total now planted in 19-20-21 is around 10,000, with a very high survival rate.

As previously notified, our last 2021 planting days are this coming Thursday 14 October (anytime between 9 and midday) and Saturday 30th October (same times). Wet of fine.

As usual there will be a variety of jobs onsite even if you can't wield a spade.
